Please support this by donating any unwanted mobile phone, battery and memory card (if applicable).

Phones in good working order are re-used around the world, while others are recycled according to environmental requirements.

Our target amount is €1850 each inc vat & delivery

Heartsafety Solutions will then donate €100 to The Cormac Trust for every defibrillator purchased through this scheme.

If we exceed the target we can use the surplus to purchase ancillary equipment such as cabinets, child pads or further training.
